

## Water - The Coming Big Issue.

Water, precious water, something we take for granted in our modern society - turn on a tap and it's freely available. This article is not the product of research but of observation over a thirty year period. When I was thirteen in 1964 I perchanced to see the original movie of George Orwells' "1984". It had a profound effect on me and its' message is one I have never forgotten and is largely responsible for an awareness of world events which ultimately led me to the truth, our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom I gave my life in 1985.

Similar to the effect of the movie, in 1972 I read a copy of a university commemoration week magazine that was full of jokes, articles and other nonsense etc. One of the articles was a spoof article about an Irish farmer out west of Mt. Isa who refused to obey the World Water Authority (WWA) and persisted in catching his own rainwater. After repeated warnings the WWA sent in a contingent of Fijian troops to sort him out. The farmer died in the fight but not before taking many of the troops with him. To express its' gratitude the W.W.A. gave the families of the dead troops a one year free supply of water. How generous! It was supposed to be a spoof article but the emerging events tend to indicate the anticipa-

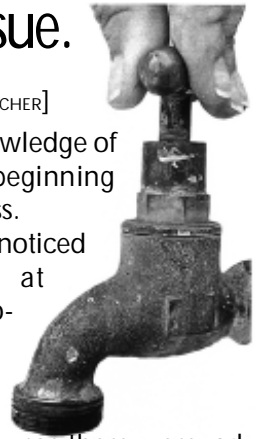
tion or foreknowledge of what is now beginning to come to pass.

Then in 1991 I noticed a billboard at Strathpine advocating water conservation and in 1993

while in Melbourne there were advertisements on television advocating water conservation followed by the six

o'clock news showing the spillways on the dams open to get rid of the water because the rains were coming. I failed to see the logic or common sense in the advertisements.

Despatch has recently published information written by Dr. Stanley Monteith, the American researcher and author which exposes the intentions of the World Bank (W.B.) to take control of virtually the entire water supply of the world, using our governments as police to enforce its' policies. Now of course the aims of the W.B. are presented as being a marvellous plan by visionary humanitarians to ensure the sus-



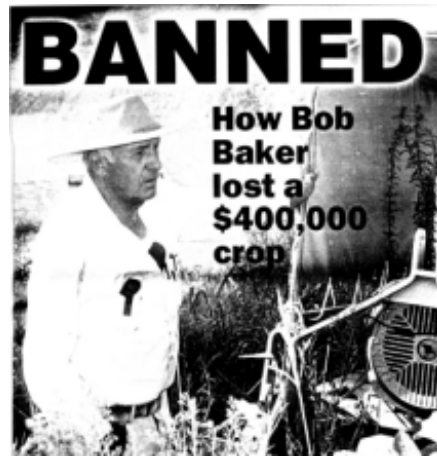

tainable availability of water to all the worlds' people. The articles, which follow, appear to fit the framework as outlined by Dr. Monteith.

We are just beginning to emerge from one of the worst droughts on record and it makes good sense if we do not waste water but recent articles in community newspapers seem to be consistent with the theme advocated by the **World Bank**. There have been several articles in the media recently highlighting the plight

of Australian farmers struggling to survive in the current drought. As though the drought isn't enough, many are being hampered because the farmers do not have open access to the bores of the great artesian basin. Studies have shown the enormous underground water supply is gradually depleting and it must be admitted that a more careful usage would be desirable but there is something wrong when our farmers are denied access to these bores in desperate times, except to bid for, as one example, seventy thousand megalitres that that was auctioned towards the end of 2002. Those who could afford it bought water and the rest missed out. Two more cases of hardship

A rational person might assume that these deep waterholes on Neurum Creek fronting his property would provide sufficient irrigation to finish a watermelon crop in its vital last three to four weeks of growth.

But not so. Queensland's Department of Natural Resources slapped a pumping ban on Neurum Creek late in November 2002, effectively destroying a watermelon crop worth up to \$400,000 which would have been Bob and Betty Baker's principal income for the year.

The Bakers have done everything possible to conserve water, shutting off irrigation to their other crops of turf, lucerne and sorghum and applying water to the melons with a highly efficient and water saving system of T-Tape drip irrigation.

This careful water use apparently fell on deaf ears among DNR officers who insisted the Bakers stop pumping and abandon their nearly half million dollar melon crop - a ban that came without any prior warning.

The bureaucratic absurdity gets even worse. DNR has given the Bakers permission to pump water from the Stanley River; a slimy mess with insufficient water to pump.

**"The Hidden Dangers of The Rainbow"** Constance Cumbey makes reference to one of the aims of the NAM as being the establishment of a **World Water Authority**. Water is now being treated as a scarce natural resource. In some parts of the world that is the case but it shouldn't be in Australia. Again Australia is the fourth largest continent with only twenty million people.

**With a little vision and planning one wonders what Australia's potential would really be?**

As Australia is submitting to the U.N. via the international treaties that have been signed we are no longer in control of our destiny.

Ultimately all this is another way of gaining totalitarian control!

The **basic sustaining unit** is water, even before food. No water means no crops, no cattle, a forced serfdom in the end, nations begging water from cruel masters. It is happening already. made the headlines in January 2003. The first concerned the citrus growers of Gayndah in Qld. Most of the orchards there had used nearly all of their water allocation but they still needed more to bring the fruit to harvest. The Gayndah council operating under the requirements of the local council act put the excess water up for tender. Most of it was sold to a gold mine in an adjoining shire. Only one orchard was able to buy water, the rest missed out. A \$48 million industry was put in jeopardy for the sake of less than \$60 thousand.

The second case concerns a farmer at Mount Archer who had a \$400,000 watermelon crop. He needed another

15-20 megalitres to complete his crop but the Dep't of natural resources refused him permission to pump water from the water holes on his property but gave him permission to pump from a river, which had insufficient slimy water to pump. The pages of the "Country Life" newspaper January 16 2003 showed the farmer sitting in the field surrounded by rotting watermelons.

The third case concerns the

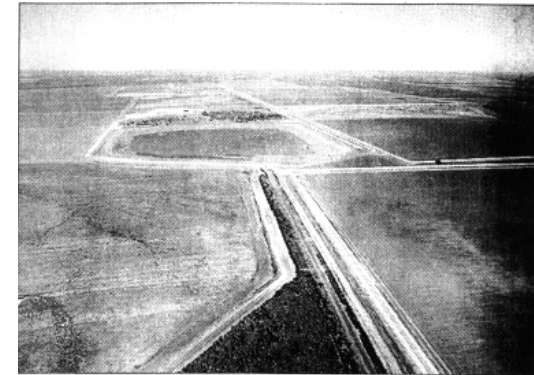
changing of fee structure, which will apply to 1200 holders licensed to harvest water. This particularly affects the largest cotton producing properties. The example given in the Courier Mail was **"Cubbie"** station which until now has paid the State Government \$3700 for the privilege of storing 440,000 megalitres during major floods. Under the new scale of fees **"Cubbie"** station would be required to pay \$1.32 million. When this was announced in early January thirty of the water harvesters were determined they would not pay the fees.

**Need it be pointed out that farms are where our food comes from not**

**from supermarkets?**

It would seem that certain government departments now hold enormous power over the farming community and it doesn't take much imagination to foresee the disasters that may befall us in the not to distant future.

As a result of the recent drought the local Redcliffe community newspaper "The Redcliffe and Bayside Herald" is now running a

QUEST COMMUNITY NEWSPAPERS programme called the **"Taps Off"** programme in which they will be monitoring the city's "water consumption" throughout the year. They're helping the challenge to see average water usage fall from 220 kilolitres per property per year down to 209 kls.

**So where is this leading us?**

**If we can reduce our consumption by 11 kilolitres, why not more?**

**Why not down to 40 litres per person per day, which is the figure, the World Bank is advocating as a sustainable figure?**

Take note of this quote from the Herald article-

"In our nine month Taps Off campaign, culminating in Water week in October, we aim to educate and entertain you. In this International Year of Fresh-water we want to champion the water savers and expose the big wasters and we need you to tip us off".

About 1982 I was sent up to the construction site at the Wivenhoe dam and so it was with interest that about the same time I read an article in the COURIER-MAIL stating that when the Wivenhoe dam was filled it would contain enough water for the entire Brisbane area for seven years without any additional rainfall. The population has grown considerably since then but we don't usu-

ally go seven years without rain and there are several other dams beside the Wivenhoe and the Somerset.

Over the past several years most shires have fitted water meters to properties. Like bar codes on products they are a perfect system for rationing. The slogan used in advertising re water meters was-**"Pay only for the water you use"** whereas in reality the intent is-**"You will pay for every drop you use"** and indeed the price of water, like petrol, is rising.

The United Kingdom has a population of sixty million people and there is no difficulty in providing sufficient water for them so why is it that the people of Australia which is thirty times bigger with a population of only twenty million people are being told to cut back. **What about New York City or Tokyo with about eight million people each?** They can provide sufficient water. Something is seriously amiss. The fact of the matter is it doesn't matter what country we are talking about, all countries are going to be forced to reduce consumption. Many Biblical commentators have stated that there is to be a socialist style redistribution of the world's resources, **but how would you redistribute water from Australia where it is plentiful and take it elsewhere?** Obviously we would be charged a higher price here and it would subsidise water programmes

elsewhere in the world.

From the COURIER MAIL article which mentions water theft it appears that we now have what is considered a new major crime-water theft. In the accompanying article we are now being told that water theft in Queensland is **"a low and despicable act"**. Queensland Liberal Party leader, Mr. Bob Quinn said,

"Resources, satellites and investigators are what catch and stop water theft..."

Surely a better solution would be to provide more water but more water would probably mean more dams and that would be very environmentally unfriendly! Remember back to the mid eighties when the Tasmanian Government wanted to build the Gordon above Franklin dam?

It was stopped when Prime Minister, Bob Hawke appealed to a UNESCO treaty.

"In October the federal parliament received the Rose Report, which stated that the federal government had the power to stop the construction of the dam under it's obligation to the provisions of the UNESCO Convention for the Protection of the World Cultural and Natural Heritage (1972), to which Australia was a signatory in 1974 ... The federal Labor Party in November announced that the government

and the opposition were obliged, because of the nomination for the world heritage listing, to prevent the construction of the dam... " The area was placed on the World Heritage list.

"...On the 14th. December 1982 the South West Tasmania area was added to the World Heritage List."
