FIVE SIMPLE RULES

(1) Realize that we can know nothing that we can be sure about, apart from the revelation of the Divine Word.

(5) Feed spiritually upon His Word. Read devotionally the passages which show who God, the Lord Jesus and the Holy Spirit really are. The Bible will lead you into knowing God personally, and into worship and adoration of our Glorious Creator. Knowledge, not experience, is the way to Truth. Jesus Christ is Truth revealed in the Bible, the Logos.

Experience with the Divine Lord will bring sweet contentment, precious communion, happiness, and peace that the world can never know, and a growing understanding of the depth and height of the loving Father's compassion toward His people.



QUESTIONS.

a. Why are experiences unreliable in regard to finding absolute Truth? Why is "your truth is your truth and my truth is my truth" a subjective, nonsense way to find Truth in reality? Why can't truth just be subjective, or based on our own senses or "truth" inside ourselves?

b. Why is real experience in God important, godly, and true to a Biblically balanced life in Christ?

experience. All that we need to understand about God's nature, purpose, revelation to man, plan for the future of this earth, plan of salvation, God's love, justice, judgment, and sovereignty has been already given in the Word of God. The guidance, instruction in righteousness, revelation of doctrine, exhortation, and wisdom of a thousand, thousand lifetimes are all there in God's Word.

We should never go to "the Spirit" alone without the Word. To do so is to open ourselves up to DELUSION and DECEPTION from the enemy. The Spirit and the Word must agree. It is one thing to rejoice in the experience of the Lord God as a living reality in our lives. It is quite another to base guidance, truth, revelation, prophecy, and doctrine on experience. To do so is to throw the gates of our souls open to the doctrines of seductive and wicked spirits.

5. Is Living a Christ-Centered Life about "Experience," and Doctrinal Correctness and Holiness of Life?

There is no Christ-centered life without experience of Him. There is no Real Revival without Christ as the center. There is no godly doctrinal correctness and holiness of life without knowing Him, day by day. If we truly yield to Him, obey Him through the instructions of the Scriptures, worship Him in devotional prayer, and seek Him with all our hearts, we will have experience with Him. He lives! (Psi 63:1-4).

The Lord will make us aware of Him in His way and time. We don't have to help Him do so, as is the practice of many today. We should never try to sense God, feel Him, image or visualize Him. God reveals to us His character in the Bible. Our devotional life with Him must be made firm on the revelation of Scripture.

God the Father and the Spirit are Spiritual Beings. Jesus Christ is seated, at this period of time, at the right hand of God in Heaven. He is not now in the flesh, although He has a glorified, immortal Body. We apprehend Him through the agency of the Holy Spirit who draws us to Him, never to the Holy Spirit Himself. Paul was determined to not know Christ after the flesh (II Cor 5:16).

Let God Himself reveal Himself to the obedient, totally surrendered believer as He will. May the Lord warm sad, cold hearts

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INTRODUCTION.

The 21st century is proving to be an earth-shattering experience for every person on the world! For the masses of people who are ignorant and apathetic of the true state-of-affairs on this benighted planet, most of their lives are being either disrupted by crisis, destroyed utterly, broken by war, or are filled with sadness, fear of events and hopelessness.

They know "something is up" and try to hide their heads in the sand like the proverbial ostrich – crying

"I don't know"

and I don't care!"

Running madly after material goods, entertainment and sexual adventure, oblivion through drugs or booze, they are pathetic to watch! In the Western cultures their "entertainments" show the horror of the unsaved people's mind-set. Death and perversion dominate, there are ghastly scenes of bloody killings, autopsies and every type of sexual perversion known to man on television in the 21st



century! The unsaved people are in death's valley!

For the servants of Satan or Lucifer the 21st century is a time that fills their hearts with glee. They can see a mighty victory up ahead, the counterfeit Christ, the Beast, will soon be announcing his sovereignty over the billions of fallen souls in rebellion against the Almighty God. True Biblical Christianity has almost been obliterated by the false teachers and prophets, the Super Churches with their sickening doctrines of Self and materialistic greed. This is the magical Illumination Age which countless occultists of many disciplines have yearned for, have conspired to bring about for eons. Never has Satan and his demons seen such a wonder – the Man of Sin has thrown out the true Christ and His followers, spiritualism and Satanism reign supreme. Or so they think!

For the Remnant Church, those who are genuinely saved, who worship the one true God, who will not compromise with the deceptions that the denominations are wantonly pandering themselves with, this is a momentous time indeed! Some, not many, are standing firm and witnessing to the lost, pulling souls from the fire. They are alerting those who are ignorant and apathetic, seeking to bring light in love and compassion. Bravely opposing the Antichrist system, lifting up a banner against the Luciferian One World government. Some have been imprisoned for their truthful insight and fearless appraisal. LIGHT always moves, it is constantly moving. Darkness, conversely, does not move, it is only the absence of light. Spiritual Light moves in on the darkness of sin, it is always moving, it is bringing awareness with it, it overwhelms the dark wherever it is:

“Give glory to the LORD your God, before he cause darkness, and before your feet stumble upon the dark mountains, and, while ye look for light, he turn it into the shadow of death, and make it gross darkness.” Jeremiah 13: 16.

There are some in the Remnant Church, who are so shocked at global and Church events that they have retreated into their homes, shut the doors and they grieve. They have lost the victory they should have in Christ Jesus, and have given into emotion and see only the weakness of their own selves. There are some who will not face facts, and do not seek to understand because to understand spoils their enjoyment of life. These are perhaps the

through the Holy Spirit (II Cor 4:10-11; John 14:21).

Can we really imagine that breath-taking words such as the following can be known in fullness without knowing and experiencing God?

“The Lord is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit” (Psi 34:18).

“And the peace of God which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus” (Phil 4:7).

What are just a few of the ways a Christian can experience God, without these experiences being counterfeit and demonic? Examples might be:

(a) The sinner comes to the foot of the Cross in repentance. He there accepts Christ as Savior. His guilt, shame and hopelessness are taken away by the Lord Almighty, and his whole being is filled with a glorious joy unspeakable. He knows he has passed from death to life. He becomes suddenly aware that God is with him. This is reality, experience, as well as belief in the salvation verses.

(b) There has been a period of severe trial in the life of a Christian couple. A child is very ill. The father has lost his employment. Their church fellowship has been soured. The wife's elderly mother has died. In the midst of these painful matters, they kneel together in prayer. A fullness of peace and joy floods their beings. It is as if they are enfolded in the arms of the Almighty. It is as though they hear a voice say, *“... be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed, for the Lord thy God is with thee wherever thou goest.”* They are filled with new confidence and trust that all is well. Later, reading their daily devotional book, the verse Joshua 1:9 is under that day's date. This is an experience with God which no one could ever adequately explain to the godless heart.

In many ways, we can experience God as we *“walk in the Spirit.”* Sometimes God shows Himself in dramatic ways. Never, however, are these manifestations of the Lord contrary to His Word—aimed at the senses, the body and the soul—nor are they in any way occultic in nature, nor unholy sensuality.

What About Basing Our Lives on Doctrine and the Scriptures?

To subject ourselves to the Scriptures as the only source of Truth does not mean that we must reject godly, doctrinally sound

revealed Word to the natural world, never the other way. Subjective experiences in regenerated people, who still live in a fallen world, should not dictate to the objective Word of Truth. The Bible should always dictate to the experience (II Tim 3:16-17; Dan 10:21; Rom 15:4-6).

2. The acceptance of the Bible as the only way a believer encounters God, or by which He manifests Himself to His saved ones, is NOT Scriptural. Through the Holy Spirit, Jesus Christ is ever with His blood-bought one. He lives. He “walks with me and talks with me, along life’s narrow way” The area of loving, worshipping, adoring, and responding to a Divine Person is not merely doctrinal. The experiences of God in a Christian’s life should be rich and fulfilling, humbling and precious indeed.

The battle between the Latter Rainites, the Emerging Church, Pentecostal extremists and the Bible-based Christians should never become one of plain doctrine versus experience. It should be between these opposing views:

(a) False experiences of the evil spirits versus true biblical experiences;

(b) The basis of Truth is subjective experience versus the basis of Truth is the objective, infallible, revealed Word of God, our only authority.

4. What Is the Difference Between “Walking in the Spirit” and Holding the Sound Belief that All Authority for Faith and Doctrine Is in the Infallible Word of God?

Here, lies the problem area with many sincere Bible-based Christians. They rightfully are appalled by the extreme experience-centered movements, and may then retreat into a cold legalism, which is presumed to be godly Christian living. However, the Scriptures instruct the believer to “walk in the Spirit,” to be “filled with the Spirit” (Gal 5:25; Eph 5:18).

This is far more than mere intellectual agreement, and more than only a mental belief in God. To live godly lives, we must have faith and belief. We also enter into fellowship with God. We should obey the Father in His Grace, and His Son will become manifest unto us. The latter is an “experience” with Christ Jesus

most selfish of all – babies in the faith.

Which group are you in? The ignorant and apathetic, the fearless soldiers in Christ Jesus’ army, the retreated and shell-shocked Christians, or the babies who only want mother’s milk and a nap? We need to answer that question, every one of us, and all of us put on the whole armour of God. Ephesians 6:10-18. Perhaps you have never been saved by trust in the Lord Jesus Christ? Then it is time to get in the Lifeboat which is Jesus our Saviour. John 3:16.

This book is a simple answer book – for those who are forthright and earnest enough to ask questions. **God’s Word has all the answers – it is a BLAZE OF LIGHT in the Darkness.** We will not stumble upon the dark mountains if we have Light from God’s Lamp. But, we need to know what it actually says. Many do not know, and so are deceived, often through laziness and lack of proper study of the Word. The Bible is not a book of confusion and perplexity. It is a revelation from God.

CHAPTER ONE.

LIGHT TURNED ON: Kingdom Now Heresy.



Why is it wrong to say that the Christian Churches should all unite and establish a Kingdom of God on earth?

This seems perfectly reasonable at first glance.

Why do we allow mere doctrines and dogmas to separate the churches of God?

Isn’t it reasonable and victorious to step out in faith and take the world for Jesus, together?

Forgetting differences, marching against evil.

Haven’t we been promised in Psalm 2:8:

“Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession.”

The Kingdom Now teachers say that the churches are to receive this promise with faith. It is in black-and white,

how can it be wrong?

1. The most serious error of *Kingdom Now* or *Dominion Theology*

is the belittling of Jesus Christ that is inherent in these doctrines. Power-hungry leaders will not wait for the King to come and establish His Kingdom, they want to establish a kingdom themselves and for themselves. They see themselves as Super-Apostles with a mandate to rule on earth, with all the honour and riches this will give them, personally. One would imagine that the Lord Jesus Christ could not bring the Kingdom of God on earth without these pompous leaders' proud endeavours. Nothing could be further from reality – Jesus Christ is GOD and needs no man to aid Him in setting up His Kingdom – it will be here in its God ordained time and way.

2. Churches which call themselves “Christian” are not always true to their designation. Many have false salvation messages, political activists and communists in leadership, and humanists teaching lies against the Bible in control of the denominations. Unity can never be achieved if false doctrines are embraced, against the Bible teaching. Doctrines are not the same as “dogmas.” Dogmas are creations of churches and religious councils, rules and regulations and dogmatic statements. “Doctrines” include the doctrines of the Bible itself, and these must never be discarded or compromised. If Bible Christians leave Truth they have lost the Way and Life as well. Jesus Christ said this:

“Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.”

Salvation itself depends on Truth and
Jesus Christ alone as the Way.

3. **Psalm 2:8** is not a promise to the churches of Christendom.

It is a promise to Jesus Christ, the Messiah, that He will take over and rule the whole earth.

Do you doubt this? Then let us examine the Bible verses carefully. **NOTE** that God is speaking to His Son, His only begotten Son, Jesus Christ (John 3:16). Not known in the Old Testament by the name Jesus Christ, but revealed as the coming Messiah. Note that the Psalm finishes with honour for the Son, Who has set up His Kingdom. The Psalm looks to the future when He has broken the rebels on earth with a rod of iron and has dashed them in pieces like a potter's vessel. :

*“Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion.
I will declare the decree: the LORD hath said unto me, Thou art my Son; this day have I begotten thee.*

right which it is counterfeiting? It would be a nonsense world. No, Satan is certainly a master of the counterfeit. However, the True must stand on its own merits, with the only proofs accepted being Scriptural, i.e., Satan is NOT counterfeiting a biblical “drunk in the Spirit” experience, which is a fake of a legitimate “drunk” experience from God

(Jas 1:22; I Jn 1:8; Gal 6:3; I Cor 3:18; Jas 1:26;
Gal 6:7; I Cor 6:9, 15:33).

3. Is the Legalistic Denial of All Experience Really What the Lord Requires?

The backlash against the modern-day experience-centered fiasco has become extreme in itself. If one opposes an error too strenuously, one often goes too far, and ends in a counter-error. A legalistic, doctrine-centered, coldly intellectual faith is NOT the Faith of our Fathers. It is not New Testament teaching.

There are two main areas in the doctrine-centered concept. One is perfectly Scriptural and sound. The other is almost Bible idolatry. The Faith Movement accuses the “fundamentalists” of worshipping a God who extends no further than the leather covers of their Bibles. In some instances, the critics may be quite accurate.

Two Areas of Bible-Centred Belief.

1. The acceptance of the Bible as the sole authority for faith and doctrine, and as the only revealed, infallible Word of God is God-honoring and Scriptural. Nor should any truths about God be sought outside the pages of the Book which He has spoken through, that is, apart from its pages.

For example, the Bible reveals that God is the Father, and Christ Jesus is His begotten Son. It reveals nothing deeper about those relationships which would aid our understanding, in a natural sense. We know naturally that a father is older than a son, and that begotten means that once the father existed but the son did not exist.

The Bible, however, shows us that the Son of God had no beginning and no end—that the Father, Son and Holy Spirit co-existed eternally. Therefore, the Father is NOT older than the Son.

We must always proceed in our understanding of God from the

the arms, a breath of wind, or a loss of all control and consciousness. The mind is switched off; the victim becomes yielded and without will. Some-times, the eyes become glazed, and the person is drunken-like. The body may float, levitate and become subject to the spirits entirely.

The emotions can be so heightened by ecstasy that a sensual excitement engulfs the soul, rather like a sexual climax. This is not of God; it is religious sensuality. This can be very thrilling, and induce compulsion to the spiritual interference, similar to drug-produced experiences (Eph 2:2; II Cor 2:11).

The real Presence of God is entirely different. When God moves, He communes with the spirit of the believer. The body and soul are awake and fully alert. The spirit is softened, and the will remains free, but God draws gently into a conformity to His will. There is always beauty, harmony, holiness, and grace when God makes His Presence manifest. Never does the Holy Spirit of the Lord bring about foolish, uncouth or unclean actions. He can fill a room with His Presence, but the spirit is affected, never the senses and the body. The body may be overcome by the Presence of God, but is not the center of a spiritual phenomenon.

An emotion of love surely comes toward God, but never a sensual perversion. The emotional response in a godly experience is secondary, holy, uplifting, and pure. The believer is made aware of God by an enlightening in the spirit, very seldom by an appearance which the senses, such as the eyes, the nose or the ears, apprehend (Heb 10:38; II Pet 1:2-8).

Churchgoers in these days, in the majority, believe that all spiritual experience which is pleasant is from God. They imagine them-selves to be beyond deception. If deceptions are detected, the confused victim may still hang doggedly to the concept of the deception.

The Church cliché, "If there is a counterfeit, there must be an authentic experience, for Satan is only a counterfeiter and he must have copied something that is real in God!" is embraced fervently. Sadly, it is not consistently true that every false experience has an authentic godly one which is being copied. What kind of world would it be if we all based our lives on the idea that if something is wrong and evil, there must be something good and

Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession.

Thou shalt break them with a rod of iron; thou shalt dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel.

Be wise now therefore, O ye kings: be instructed, ye judges of the earth. Serve the LORD with fear, and rejoice with trembling. Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and ye perish from the way, when his wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all they that put their trust in him."

Revelation 2: 26, 27 is used also to "prove" that united Christendom is promised the rule over nations, BEFORE Christ returns. This is untrue. The speaker in the passage is Christ Himself. Firstly, here are the verses:

"And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations:

And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father."

The main questions we must ask about these verses are

"To whom is the promise given?"

And **"When will it be fulfilled, what is the time slot?"**

These verses were primarily addressed to the Church of Thyatira, see verse 18. Thyatira was an actual church, A.D. 500- 1500. This message of Christ's to the church was about a believing remnant who would not embrace the apostasy and evil teachings of Nicolaitanism and Balaamism. These false religious beliefs involved sacrificing to idols, religious immorality and heathenism. The named church was guilty of apostasy, there was a believing Remnant. Jesus Christ declared that sincere believers should hold fast, and not lose the truths that they still had. If they overcame, obeyed God's Word and did Christ's works until the end, He would bless them when He came back to earth. He would give them "power over the nations" in the Millennial Reign on earth, after He had returned and set up the Kingdom. The overcomer would share in Christ's triumph over the wicked nations, and he would receive a

position under Christ's authority in the Kingdom.

The address has also a secondary application - to any church which seeks to obey God. Any who overcome will rule with Christ Jesus when He sets up His Kingdom on earth. The time slot is after the Rapture, after the Tribulation, after the Second Advent of Christ.

Nowhere does the Bible promise that the united churches of Christendom will rule on earth NOW (or *ever* for that matter) or that these heretical churches would have power over the nations! The very religious evils exposed in the message to Thyatira are amongst the evils committed by the Kingdom Now churches that want to unite and rule the world! They are greedy for material goods and money, mix with pagans and charlatans, embrace obviously demonic manifestations, have left sound doctrine far behind, teach false salvation messages, and encourage immorality with lustful Rock music and sensuous "worship" behaviour. Much more could be said here.

4. The whole world is uniting, politically and religiously.

This is not a unity of God, it is a Satanic unity that will culminate with the Antichrist taking absolute control of a global amalgamation of nations. The false prophets of the Kingdom Now movement are being exposed as partners in crime with the Illuminati who are setting up the New World Order. Much evidence of this fact is appearing on Internet and is being sent out through DVDs. An example, Rick Warren, Benny Hinn, Bill Hybels, Kenneth Copeland, Robert Schuller – all of this ilk – are members of Illuminati organizations or are Freemasons, which is Illuminati. Rick Warren is on the Round Table of the Council on Foreign Relations, a major New World Order organization. This is about FACT not theory. All that Dominion Theology or Kingdom Now will do is unite the gullible churches with the One World Church of the Fabian, Luciferian Global State. Do not take part in this movement, it will bring any who cooperate under the domination of the Antichrist system.

QUESTIONS.

1. Why is it wrong to try and unite all "Christians" together in peace? Where does the Bible say this is wrong?

The Bible warns us of false teachings and prophets, it never

seducing, spiritual lies.

To retreat from the safety of the Holy Spirit-breathed Scriptures to seek guidance, truth and doctrine in extra-biblical phenomena is to court disaster, and is forbidden by God (Rev 22:18-19; II Tim 3:16). These very experiences of a false nature are bringing about the apostasies and evil doctrines of the Latter Rain and the Faith Movement (II Pet 2:1).

If any should seek visions, revelations or prophecies for their own glory, enjoyment, or to pamper their own desire to boast of their "spirituality," the adversary will answer with his counterfeits! The Spirit of God is Holy. He cannot deny the Lord. The Holy Spirit responds only for the Glory of God (II Pet 1:19-21).

(d) A common denominator which is present within most of the counterfeit experiences in the current "revivals" is a passivity which leaves reason and the workings of the mind behind. The leaders of these "revivals" often teach that people should "move in the Spirit," leave "dogma and doctrinal bondage," "receive in the Spirit," and stop "reasoning." This is diametrically opposed to the teaching of

Scripture which shows that it is the MIND that is transformed, which then leads to the growth of the Spirit:

"Be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your MIND, that ye may prove what is that good and acceptable, and perfect, will of God"

(Rom 12:1-2). (See also I Cor 14:20; Col 3:10.)

A blank mind and a passive, yielded body are not what God requires of a believer. Letting go in such a manner is the very way the emotions (the soul) and the physical being are opened to evil spirits. The natural senses are then possessed. God, however, deals with the spirit of man, who opens his mind to the transforming enlightenment of the revealed Word of God. And, the spiritual power of the Living Word thus brings life to his spirit. God works with the believer, never dominates and overthrows him (Pro 20:27; II Cor 6:1; Heb 4:12).

(e) The false "Presence of God" in the false revivals of today is felt in the body, or is present in the soul—an attack by evil spirits on the emotions. The experience might be a burning in the body (fire), thrills up the spine, a tingling in the fingers and up

laugh-ter extremes, fallings, “visions,” and “prophecies” of the Faith Movement and Latter Rain Revivalists. Why is this, if the Scriptures teach authentic Christian experiences?

The reason is simple. The Bible does not teach that such experiences are of God—quite the contrary. The false revivals of today are New Age demonic experiences under another banner. What then constitutes biblical experiences which are of God, and what constitutes demonic counterfeits? (Deut 18:10-12; Gal 5: 20; Matt 7:22, 24:24; II Thess 2:9; Rev 13:13).

(a) Biblical experiences are received from the Lord by the Spirit: God’s Spirit moves upon the spirit of the believer. Counterfeit experiences move upon the soul and the body of man. Thus, the emotions are stirred to an unstable state, the soul being the seat of the emotional life. The body is moved upon by the demonic counterfeiters, who make it tingle, fall, shake, and react in an uncontrollable manner.

(b) Biblical experiences are centered upon the Person of the Lord Jesus Christ, never upon the Holy Spirit or experience for experience’s sake. Biblical experience occurs because the believer is longing to commune with the Lord, longing to please and obey Him. If one seeks experience for itself alone, it is rather like seeking lustful things rather than falling in love with someone. The experiences of lust are many, but they can never compare with sharing a love relationship with another human being.

So it is with spiritual relationship. Experience instead of Christ alone is so self-centered that no true spiritual gain or joy results, nor do those thus deceived please God in any way. Rather, a curious frustration and a bondage to the experiences develop, and a painful desire for more which is never satisfied, ravages the deluded. They end up often seeking for another “fix” on and on.

(c) What about visions, prophecies and revelations? What about “new” teachings which leave the “old” behind? The current trend to rely on visions, prophecies and dreams has removed countless churchgoers into the extremes of existentialism. They have been drawn away from the objective Truth of the revealed Word of God (the “old”) into a subjective “truth” which relies on experience (the “new”). These visions and prophecies lead into the “doctrines of demons” shown in I Tim 4:1 to be



ever tells us to embrace them. The Bible commands believers to be separate from those who do not obey the Word, and who deny its doctrines. It does not say to unite with them. 2 Cor.6:14-17; 2 John 7-11.

The Bible warns of false prophets who will rise up in power in the Last Days.

Matt. 7:15; Matt. 24:11 & 24; Mark 13:22; 2 Peter 2:1; 1 John 4:1.

God’s Word is pure and holy and can never be mixed with false doctrines and corrupt and heretical churches. Proverbs 30:5. Jesus warned against false doctrines, He did not embrace corrupt religious leaders and their teachings. Matt. 16:12.

2. How can Christians show love if we will not unite? How can we be really people of love if we turn away from those who name the Name of Christ and profess to love Him as we do? Surely it is right to say, “I love all those who love Christ, no matter what we disagree about”?

Christians are called to love all right, but we must look at the Biblical definition of love.

The Bible is God’s Word, and it alone can define “love” not our own sentimental, weak and sinfully sweeping statements that sound good, but are like water barrels with cracks in them! Here is what the Bible tells us about love

a. We must love GOD firstly, with all our hearts, and souls, and minds, and strength.

It is not loving towards God to welcome and support those who deny Him, disobey Him, refuse to accept His Word and heap ridicule on His Truth. And this is what many of the apostate “Christian” churches do, with their leaders who hold university degrees in godless humanism and philosophy, and paganism mixed up with psychology and the New Age. Love for God will not allow us to unite with heresy and deceit.

Matthew 22:37.

b. We must love THE UNSAVED, and care enough to tell them that false doctrines of salvation will lead them to hell! The vast majority of people sitting on seats in the denominations of today are not saved people, because they have been told lies about salva-

tion. Should we just happily go along with the false teachers and leaders of these “debominations” in the name of love? Of course not. If born-again Christians have anything to do with apostate churches it should be to evangelize amongst the religious dead in the congregations. To seek to pull some out of the fire before it is too late for them. Jude 1:21-23.

c. Believers who are saved must love TRUTH, because Truth is Jesus Christ, and in Him is no darkness of error and pretext, no cheating or fraud. The Bible is very straight forward in its presentation, there is no room for error when one simply reads the words, and asks the Holy Spirit to open the Scriptures and their truth. Comparing other passages of the Bible, being diligent in study, the Truth is all there. Would it be loving Truth if I, for an example, agreed with a man whose church tells him Jesus Christ is not God, when the Bible says over and again that He is? Agreed with him in order to be loving, or if I went along with him and his “church” in order to be pleasant and unified? (See Isaiah 9:6; John 14:7-10; John 20:27-29. etc). Would I be loving Truth if I was in union with a church which worships Mary as the Queen of Heaven, and believes it crucifies Christ afresh every time it “celebrates” the abominable Mass? Or a church that delights in manifestations of a demonic nature? 1 John 3:19; 2 Thess. 2:8-12.

d. Christians must love and be lead by the authentic Holy Spirit! A false “Holy Spirit” is leading many churches to destruction and amalgamation with the devil and his Man of Sin, the Beast or Antichrist. True Christians show love toward the Holy Spirit by their submission to Him in all things, and their obedience to God’s Word which is taught to them by the Holy Spirit. Do you think it is love towards the glorious Third Person of the Trinity to swallow lying signs and wonders and to be “tolerant” towards those who are being deceived by Satan? To actually go along with unbiblical movements that exhibit “prophecies” that are fake, “healings” that are trickery and con-artist swindles, which are led by men who extract millions of dollars every day out of easy to fleece and foolish congregations, using satanic manifestations of spiritual forces that are not of God? Of course it is not love towards the Holy Spirit. Romans 15:30; 2 Timothy 1:7.

e. The New World Order is real, not a foolish “theory”

(3) **Is living a Christ-centered life about “experience” as well as doctrinal correctness and holiness of life?**

1. Is There Scripturally Correct Experience?

To even mention that Christianity involves “experience” with God is akin to using a “naughty” word in many circles today. This is understandable; responsible people have had quite enough of the exotic displays of the existentialists in their midst. To polarize into “**no-experience-accepted**” groups versus “truth-equals-experience” groups is not the answer, however, to the shame the Christians are feeling in regard to the extremes and errors of our day. After all, godliness means more than just cold adherence to doctrine.

Godliness is walking in reality with a Living Being who loves us; and knowing Him and worshipping Him always brings experience of HIM and His dealings with us. The Bible is full of the reality of God, and the stories of the blessed characters of Scriptures who have experienced God first-hand.

There certainly is Scripturally-correct experience; and there are those of us who would never accept such disasters as the “Toronto Blessing,” yet would witness with joy of our own experience of God Himself (Exo 13:21-22; Josh 3:14-17; Eze 1:27-28; Dan 3:21-25; Acts 9:3-6, 18:9-10; II Cor 12:1-4; Rev 1:17-20, and more).

Is God greater than the Bible? Of course He is. He is the Maker of Heaven and Earth, and of all that is in limitless Space. He in-habits Eternity. God has no beginning and no end. He is both transcendent and imminent. He is omnipotent, omnipresent and omniscient. We live and move and have our very being in God. Of course, He is greater than a book, the Bible.

This does not mean, though, that He has NOT limited His revelation of Truth and of Himself to a certain Book, as we shall discover under question three later on (Gen 1:1; Exo 3:14; Psl 50:1-6; Isa 57:15; Rev 1:8, 20:11).

2. Are Present “Revival” Experiences Alien to the Bible?

Mature Christians are shocked by the roarings, shakings,

"The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance." 2 Peter 3:9.

CHAPTER FIVE.

LIGHT TURNED ON:

Why is mystical experience not a way to find Truth?

Should we deny all spiritual experience as possibly counterfeit?

"I was suddenly overwhelmed by the Spirit and almost waited to the floor, my arms and legs were tingling with power."

"I felt a warmth rising in my throat, and laughter burst forth which I could not contain. I roared with the delight of it and a shaking surged through my body."



These sorts of "experience" have flooded through Christendom in the recent false "Revival" Movements, which are sweeping millions into an altered state of consciousness which parallels New Age religious phenomena. As with all controversial developments in the Church scene, a Scriptural balance must be maintained. By this is meant, not dialectics, or coming to a compromise, but keeping on an even keel.

In terms of balance and Truth, the following questions should be addressed:

(1) **Is there Scripturally correct experience?**

Is God greater than the Bible?

(2) **Are the present day "revival" experiences alien to the Bible?**

(3) **Is a legalistic denial of all experience really what God requires?**

(4) **What is the difference between "walking in the Spirit" and holding the sound belief that all authority**

dreamed up by paranoid fear-mongers. CHAPTER TWO.

LIGHT TURNED ON:

Do believers have Eternal Security in Christ Jesus or Not?



This subject is really the most important on of all. The answer is not "endure to the end" and you will be saved, but "accept the truth of Grace" and you are saved. Why is it WRONG to say, "I believe that to be saved we must trust in Jesus Christ 's sacrifice for sin, endure to the end, i.e. live a good life to the end. If we don't we will be lost." Why is it WRONG and sinful to **deny** the Eternal Security of the saved believer - in Christ Jesus alone, without one good deed? Because it nullifies and degrades the Precious Blood that was shed for the sin of the world. Because it proudly declares that unmerited Grace is not strong enough to save sinners for eternity. Because somewhere in that thinking are WORKS for salvation, because it is felt that WORKS must be kept up or salvation will be lost. Grace is not Grace if works are added.

The real question: is a person saved who believes that good works must be kept up for life, or salvation will be lost? The answer is clear from the Bible, NO, that person is not saved. Why? Because they will not accept what God declares, that they are lost, helpless, sinful through and through, and unable to bring forth

righteousness from within themselves. They do not believe God when He gives them the message of undeserved Grace, which is the only way a lost sinner can really be saved.

Is a person saved who asserts that believers cannot be saved for eternity by Grace alone, but that they can take themselves away from God and be lost again if they become sinful etc. Is a person saved by Grace if they assert this? It is hard to believe that they are, for the missing factor so essential for their salvation is not present in them. What is that factor? They do not see that they themselves are sinful, fallen, can never improve, have only Christ's righteousness credited to their account to depend on. God's gift in Christ includes imparted righteousness, the new creation by the Holy Spirit, all else is filthy rags in God's sight, all of the natural man is corrupt. We can lose fellowship with God by drifting away in worldliness and sin, but we cannot lose relationship. When we are truly saved we receive a new life altogether in Christ Jesus, ETERNAL LIFE freely given, and we must yield to Him every moment that He might give to us His righteousness. We should want to be filled with Christ's righteousness, not in order to be saved but because we are saved. Most Christians sin quite a lot every day, does this mean they will be lost again? Unless they repent straight away? No. Most Christians in these terrible days do not even count bad tempers, irritability, unkindness and selfishness as sin. It is by Grace of God alone that He has had mercy upon us, and has sent the Son of God to die in our place. How devastating it would be if God made salvation dependent in any way upon our own works! No one could possibly be saved! For in us dwells "no good thing", and only Christ Who is our Life is good.

GRACE STANDS SUPREME.

There are three principles that cannot coexist with Grace:

1. Any recognition of human guilt;
2. Any recognition of human obligation.
3. Any recognition of human merit.

1. The LAMB OF GOD has taken away the sin and guilt of the world, this is the only way that Grace can be exercised toward any sinner. Only by the absolute removal of the condemnation of

pointed, and the bounds of their habitation;

That they should seek the Lord, if haply they might feel after him, and find him, though he be not far from every one of us:

"And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:" Hebrews 9:27.

Wonder of wonders, the CROSS OF JESUS CHRIST was the place of judgment of SIN.

No one need suffer under the judgment of God for sin if they will accept the provision made in Christ Jesus.

Who is responsible, it is the rebellious one who refuses Grace and mercy to the bitter end of life!!! Where do you stand, reader? The coming of the Lord will happen, in His time and in His glory, be



other. But this is simply to uncover or make manifest what previously existed in principle. Deeds done in the body are taken as the criterion of judgment because deeds declare character. The inward state is, of course, presupposed. No secret thing is hidden from God. The union with men by faith with Christ will be a cardinal fact which will be recognized. The great 'deed,' the 'true work of God,' is that men believe on Christ (John 6:29). No other deed means so much as this. It is the mother deed, the root principle, of all good deeds. All the good deeds which God approves are in principle the offspring of this. It is the gift of God's grace. Christians, then, are not saved by works, but by grace through faith. They are rewarded according to the use they make of the grace as manifest in deeds."

DIVINE JUDGMENT IS A SOBERING FACT!

The Old Testament clearly teaches God's judgment will come on all:

"Thou hast rebuked the heathen, thou hast destroyed the wicked, thou hast put out their name for ever and ever.

O thou enemy, destructions are come to a perpetual end: and thou hast destroyed cities; their memorial is perished with them.

But the LORD shall endure for ever: he hath prepared his throne for judgment." Psalm 9: 5-7.

"O worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness: fear before him, all the earth. Say among the heathen that the LORD reigneth: the world also shall be established that it shall not be moved: he shall judge the people righteously.

Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof.

Let the field be joyful, and all that is therein: then shall all the trees of the wood rejoice. Before the LORD: for he cometh, for he cometh to judge the earth: he shall judge the world with righteousness, and the people with his truth." Psalm 96:9-13.

The New Testament reveals that God will judge this earth:

"And hath made of one blood all nations of men for to dwell on all the face of the earth, and hath determined the times before ap-

ALL SIN could the way be made clear for the absolute bestowal of the Grace of God. God removes guilt in that ALL sin is able to be forgiven in Christ. God wants to lavish His riches on undeserving sinners. God has laid on Christ the iniquity of us all. If you will not let Grace reign alone, then you will not let God remove all guilt and concept of demerit in your understanding. You are not willing that Grace should occupy the field alone in the full blaze of its glory.

2. Grace cannot remain Grace if by its benefits there "is created and imposed the slightest obligation for payment or remuneration. Grace is unrecompensed favor. Its riches must be bestowed and received only on the ground that it is an uncomplicated GIFT." (Sperry-Chafer).

"I give unto them eternal life." John 10:28.

"The gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." Romans 6:23.

3. Mankind is stripped utterly of any merit before God! The Lord has pronounced an all-inclusive, judicial, condemning sentence on the whole human race, both Jew and Gentile. Read these Scriptures to see that this is so. Romans 3:9; Galatians 3:22; Romans 11:32; Romans 3:19. The only exception to the condemnation of the entire race of mankind is to the individual who will accept Christ as Saviour and Lord. John 3:18; Mark 16:16; 2 Cor. 5:19. Christ is the substitutional sin-bearer John 1:29; 2 Cor.5:14 ,19. Condemnation now is because of the personal rejection of the Saviour Who bore the world's sin. God holds men as condemned, or not condemned, on the sole basis of a personal rejection, or acceptance, of all that is revealed in the Gospel of His Grace.

The SAVED ONE, saved absolutely by Grace alone, has many positions IN CHRIST JESUS that are totally secure in Grace. Grace cannot be withdrawn because of demerit, salvation is NOT on the grounds of merit at all! Thank God!

Could the Blood of the Lamb and the promises of God possibly fail?

Antichrist, crying out for God to act. This is not some sort of lack of sentimental love, it is love with a backbone, it is holy and pure:

"And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held:

And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?" Revelation 6: 9,10.

The real "Kingdom of God" is like a great epic film. It has many episodes, and it moves forward to a mighty climax. In the climax of a film all the loose ends come together, sometimes it is an unhappy ending, but things are resolved in some way in a good yarn! So, God's ending will not be unhappy, but it will bring all the loose ends together, and the UNITY of history will only be seen in the final last installment. If the climax was not righteous, if Truth and reason and RIGHT did not climax in the Kingdom of God, the whole dramatic "film" of earth's history would be meaningless. What this world needs is not just "peace" per se, it needs an iron-fisted climax against evil, a new beginning, an earth wherein righteousness and God's will are ruling, a totally new ascent into a new future. And if some of mankind will not submit to God's inevitable duty to remove all sin from this earth, they as sinful and unrepentant men must be swept away in the clean up. Jesus Christ came to rid this earth of SIN, and He will do this to the uttermost eventually, whether Henry Kissinger or George Bush or Hilary Clinton, the Mafia drug cartel, or the Antichrist himself likes it or not!

Nothing is hid from the Lord, and so everything will be revealed one day:

"For there is nothing covered, that shall not be revealed; neither hid, that shall not be known." Luke 12:2.

Even Christians under Grace will go through judgment, not for salvation, not of their fleshly works, but the judgment will be on what they have done with Jesus Christ, for reward or loss of reward. This quote from Emery H. Bancroft is helpful here:

"To judge means, literally, to discriminate, and from this follows the idea to separate. In judgment God discriminates between the righteous and the unrighteous and separates them from each

sins,
But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries. He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses: Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace? " Hebrews 10:26-29.

There will be 144,000 Jewish evangelists crying out the Gospel to the unsaved in the Tribulation period. There will be great angels appearing from Heaven, speaking out the Gospel to the rebellious people on earth. They will warn them about more severe judgments about to fall upon them, so if they still refuse God's mercy and grace **whose fault is it?:**

"And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people, Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters." Revelation 14:6,7.

History requires a final reckoning, this is a part of the corporate conscience of the human race.

It is not just the crimes of individuals that demand justice in any honorable person's mind and heart, it is the crime of nations as well. God will judge the nations in the Tribulation, because innocents have suffered, the wicked and strong have oppressed terribly the powerless and harmless nations. All through man's ghastly history on the earth MIGHT has ruled in the place of RIGHT. In the Tribulation RIGHT will be shown in God's righteousness judgments. There is coming a time when the contending forces of good and evil will be frozen in time, and a separation will occur at long last - on earth no less! On earth as it is in Heaven, Thy Kingdom, O God, will come. There are redeemed saints in the Tribulation, Tribulation saints not the Church which has been Raptured, and they actually call for the vengeance of God upon the earth's evil doers. There are souls under the altar who were murdered by the

CHAPTER THREE.

**LIGHT TURNED ON:
 Genesis Six -
 the Nephilim.**



In Genesis chapter six an astonishing record appears which many scholars have interpreted to mean "the sons of God", or Hebrew *Elohim*, are fallen angels. A high order of supernatural beings had a mysterious union with the daughters of men. Evil angels had sex with human women, bringing forth offspring which have come to be known as *Giants* or *Nephilim*.

Let us look at this strange passage:

"And it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born unto them,

That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose.

And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years.

There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown." Genesis 6: 1-4.

Some teachers will tell us that this passage does not refer to fallen angels and human women but to the Sethite (sons of God) and Cainite lines. This seems most unlikely given the fact that the iniquity of the old world increases by this union, as though a mix of evil angel and humanity brings forth very wicked offspring indeed:

"And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.

And it repented the LORD that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart." Genesis 6:5, 6.

The Bible tells us that the Last Days of wickedness on this earth will bring about judgment by God "as it was in the days of Noah." Now Noah was a godly man living in the days of the Nephilim and the strange interaction with angels and humans. Noah and his family were delivered by God from the flood that destroyed all the people on the earth. It would appear very evident that God brought such judgment because of the evil line of part angel and part human that was now populating the earth. Redemption is only possible through the Second Adam, Jesus Christ, and the polluted children of the angels and daughters of men would be beyond redemption due to their evil angel corruption of nature. There is no redemption for the fallen angels, only for mankind in the line of Adam!

Some commentators have insisted that angels cannot have sexual relations with human beings. We should investigate this statement carefully, for it involves the "son of perdition" or the Antichrist as well as the fallen angels in Genesis six.

The objection to angels beings the "Sons of God" in

righteous judgment of God;" Romans 2:5.

GOD ALMIGHTY is not only Love itself, He is Justice. History will culminate in making known to the universe the character of every man or woman on earth, whether or not they will humble themselves and receive Grace from God through the Cross of Calvary. God's judgment will culminate in a final, complete and pure vindication of His own righteousness.

Those who object to judgment often do so because they do not realise that moral law works itself out eventually. It does not operate under the material laws of our world, where evil men can flourish and simple, godly men can be persecuted. Sin and human free will have confused the everlasting moral law as it operates on this world, but this will not be true in Eternity. When Eternity breaks forth on this planet, before Christ's Second Advent, when God is purging the earth of sin in preparation for the Millennium Reign, then the faulty moral laws of this world will give way to God's justice. This will happen in the Tribulation period of seven years. Human wills are prone to evil, they make a social order that is actually disturbed, abnormal in the eyes of the unfallen universe. Judgment is a final, equitable requirement that is utterly demanded by God's holiness, and must come about because of Christ's soon coming reign on the earth in the Millennium. It is the only way that answers to the purity and conscience of the Creator.

Our own consciences demand justice, and therefore judgment. We are made in the image of God, and although this image was marred in the Fall, the new creation has brought back to believers a keen and godly conscience that mirrors God's own justice.

"Conscience," *it has been said, "is the moral glimpse which the soul obtains of the future."* (Bancroft). Unrepentant wrong doing must be uncovered, and is accompanied by fiery judgment. If a soul refuses to repent and receive Christ after hearing about the sacrifice He made on the Cross, if that soul tramples under foot the blood of Christ shed for him and refuses it and God's Grace, if he calls that blood "a sick religion, a slaughter house doctrine" or some such insult, then there is only fiery judgment ahead:

"For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for

Jude 6, 7; Genesis 6:1-4; Luke 17: 26, 27.

b. What is the Biblical proof that Satan will have a child of his own, his own "seed?"

Genesis 3:15; 2 Thessalonians 2:3.



c. Does God want His blood-bought children to be disturbed or to fear what is coming to pass on earth?

No, He does not. What does He tell us?

CHAPTER FOUR.**LIGHT TURNED ON:****How Can a Holy, Loving God bring Terrible Judgment on the Earth in the Tribulation?**

To many unbelievers the Bible appears to be harsh, unloving book with its judgments of God and revelations of hell.

Those who are saved by Christ's Blood know that God is perfect love, so how can the Bible present such seemingly contradictory statement as "God is love," and:



"For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be. And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened." Matthew 24:21.

"But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the

Genesis 6:1-4 who had relations with daughters of men is based on the words of Jesus as to the marriage relation of the redeemed in Heaven. He said,

"They neither marry, nor are given in marriage, but are as the angels of God in Heaven." Matthew 22:30; Mark 12:25.

The reasoning goes that if angels do not marry then they do not have sexual relations either. But the verse does not say that angels do not have the power to procreate, it does not necessarily follow that angels are sexless. When in a fallen state angels may well have the power to exercise their procreation powers with human women. Angels in Heaven do not multiply by procreation, angels seem to have been created "en masse", they are immortal and death does not reduce their numbers. Marriage was given by God to humans so that they could keep the earth filled with people, and to prevent the human race becoming extinct by death. There is no necessity for the righteous saved in Heaven to marry and have children, so the marriage relationship will be discontinued there. Not that husbands and wives who were so on earth will not recognize each other in a special way in Heaven, they will surely keep that love in Heaven.

Angels are shown in the Bible always as male gender. There is "Bne-Ha-Elohim," "sons of Elohim" but never "Bnoth-Ha-Elohim," "daughters of Elohim" when angels are described. Angels would not marry in Heaven if there were no female angels there! But it does not mean that they have no male generative organs, that the fallen angels could not have sexual relations with women. They may had sunken lower in the scale of being and have produced more animal sexual powers of which they had formerly been destitute. Angels are "Spiritual Beings" but can have material bodies as the Bible shows. They assume a body like a man, they can eat (Genesis 18:1-8 and Genesis 19:1-3). Man is also a Spiritual Being - who is covered with a material body. One day the saved will be more like angels than we are today. "As we have borne the image of the earthly, we shall also bear the image of the Heavenly." 1 Cor. 15:49. It is quite possible that under certain situations there can be a sexual union between the human race and fallen angels.

Fallen angels could have been attracted to the beautiful females of the human race, as described in Genesis six. They could

have had intimate relationships with them, and had mixture offspring that were so unlike ordinary human that they were “giants,” “mighty men,” “men of renown.” In Revelation 12:7-12 we read of Satan and his angels being cast out of the Heavens onto the earth, and of the great “woe” that this will bring. This will be in the middle of the Tribulation, will the fallen angels again cause human women to succumb to their lusts? The Bible says, “As it was in the days of Noah, so shall it be also in the Days of the Son of Man.” Luke 17:26-27. Could it be a new invasion of fallen angels who want offspring on this earth?

There is an interesting verse in Genesis 3:15 that brings enlightenment on the subject of the Antichrist himself. Could he be more than a human man who has been possessed by Satan, could the Antichrist be the result of Satan’s sexual relationship with a chosen woman? In order to counterfeit to the best of his ability the miraculous incarnation of Jesus Christ in a young Virgin, Mary? Some Bible scholars over the ages have believed this will be so, including Rev. Clarence Larkin. Knowing Satan and his filth she probably won’t be a virgin however, more likely a whore!

“I will put enmity between THY SEED (Antichrist) and HER SEED (Christ): IT (Christ) shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise His heel.” It seems very clear from this that one fallen angel, Satan himself, has the power of procreation, it is saying that he will beget a son. In 2 Thess.2:3 the Antichrist is called the “SON OF PERDITION.” What is “perdition?” It is a place and also a condition into which men may fall. Who is the author of perdition? Satan is, as we see in 1 Timothy 6:9 and Hebrews 10:39:

“But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition.”

“But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that believe to the saving of the soul.”

The ANTICHRIST is the SON OF PERDITION because he is the SON OF SATAN. 2 Thessalonians 2:3.

Judas was called “the son of perdition” but he was not THE son of perdition! Just as the redeemed are called “sons of God”, and angels are called “sons of God” but are not THE Son of God. Judas was especially influenced, possessed and controlled by Satan.

*“In some cases these crude rock pillars were **thought to be the abodes of gods or demons; in others, homes of the ghosts; and often as symbols of sex....**In Egypt, Horus and Sut [Set] were regarded as two living pillars, twin builders and supporters of the heavens...”*

(H.L.Haywood. *Symbolic Masonry*:

An Interpretation of the Three Degrees. p. 206-207).

Dr Cathy Burns gives a former witch’s information about the obelisk in her book *Masonic and Occult Symbols Illustrated*, p.341:

“The obelisk is a pointed four-sided shaft, the uppermost portion of which forms a pyramid. The word ‘obelisk’ literally means ‘Baal’s Shaft’ or Baal’s organ of reproduction. This should be especially shocking when we realise that we have a gigantic obelisk in our nation’s capital known as Washington’s Monument.”

(*The Last Trumpet Newsletter* (June 1086, Vol.5, Issue 6, p.2).

She comments on page 341: *“Pan, the goat god and god of sensuality, was often represented as an obelisk.”*

BAAL was an ancient god, possibly a half-man, half-angel hybrid. PAN also could have had a hybrid origin.

Even the Vatican at Rome has a giant obelisk in front of it. Symbolizing the reproductive powers of the fallen angels? The one at the Vatican once stood in ancient Egypt! Egypt was awash with the “gods” who were more than mere myths - they were and are Satanic and Nephilim manifestations. Ralph Woodrow, as cited by **Cathy Burns**, explains:

“The very same obelisk that once stood at the ancient temple which was the center of Egyptian paganism, now stands before the mother church of Romanism! This seems like more than a coincidence.”

Films have occasionally dealt with the idea of Satan having a baby which he has sired himself! *The Omen* and *Rosemary’s Baby* are amongst the more startling of these. Occultists revel in the concept that Satan will father a son, they have written of these matters in mysterious documents for centuries. Could this “Son of Perdition” be a full grown man today? Living in quiet retreat in some wooded area awaiting his revealing, or living behind a “mild mannered” front persona like Superman does in the comics? Time will tell.

UFOs and extraterrestrials. The New Agers are already using UFOs as an alternative explanation of what the Christian Rapture is all about - Christians will be whisked away to be reprogrammed by ETs, this is the belief of the New Age. The unsaved occult people know that mankind will certainly want an explanation for the sudden disappearance of perhaps 250 to 500 million people in the Rapture. Who knows how many will go, only God. It sometimes seems as though there are hardly any truly born-again Christians in our own environment!

Today stories abound of strange happenings amongst the occult elite of the planet. How far one can take these reports we do not know. There are reports of reptilian/humans who are **“shape-shifters,”** of weird beings who are not human coming from underground passages, of super-human powers and “energies” being exercised by top level Illuminati leaders who have taken over the control of the world’s political seats of power. The Illuminati are more than human, say the reports. The 21st century is an evil, perilous period when satanic, supernatural experiences are recklessly sought after by the unenlightened, and when extremely dangerous occultic practices are being treated as parlour tricks and happy little entertainments! Black witchcraft arts are taught everywhere on television, in films like Harry Potter, through books and magazines, slyly hidden in even “Christian” books, foisted upon us by psychiatrists and New Age “natural” health treatments, even sensible people indulge in such things as homeopathy and the like. Interesting info., a subject in the witchy book “Illustrated Guide to the Supernatural” lists Homeopathy as a supernatural health treatment - not “natural”. The healing comes from a spiritual source not Christian in any way. The world is vibrating with demonic activity, all this preparing a great mass of humanity for the ultimate take-over of the Nephilim, the fallen angels and their offspring. **“As it was in the days of Noah...”**

The New World Order uses the symbol of the phallus in many ways, obelisks abound in public places and at the offices of power, such as outside the White House in Washington. This is venerating the male sexual powers, but could it also be adoring the sexual prowess of the Nephilim? The lingam (the male sex organ) is symbolized as an upright pillar, used heavily in Freemasonry:

There were giants on the earth after the great flood, showing that the fallen angels had not given up on such behaviour, although it was sporadic. Genesis 6:4 says,

“There were giants (Nephilim) in the earth in those days (the days before the Flood), and also AFTER THAT.”

After the Flood. When Moses sent twelve spies into Canaan in Numbers 13:1-33, they gave account on their return of some weird beings,

“And there we saw the giants (Nephilim), and the sons of Anak, which come of the Giants (Nephilim); and we were in our own sight as grasshoppers, and so we were in their sight.”

These were like the giants of Genesis 6, where did they originate from? All of the offspring of the fallen angels were drowned in the Flood because the human race had been corrupted, and also Christ Jesus could not die for the fallen angels as the Redeemer, only for the sons and daughters of Adam. If the race of Adam had been interbred by the evil angels to a great extent, very few could have been saved on earth by the Saviour’s shed Blood. Later on, when the evil angels again came to unite with the daughters of men, God demanded the extermination of the Canaanites - so that He could get rid of the descendants of the Nephilim?

“For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;

And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly;

And turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah into ashes condemned them with an overthrow, making them an ensample unto those that after should live ungodly;” 2 Peter 2:4-6.

“And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.

Even as Sodom and Gomorrah, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire. “ Jude 6,7.

The above statements show something that cannot be argued with. It is shown that the evil angels were punished in chains, in darkness, cast down to hell because they left their FIRST ESTATE, left their habitation in the Kingdom of the Air, and came to earth. They came with the purpose to go after STRANGE FLESH and FORNICATION, even as Sodom and Gomorrha did, in "like manner" to these wicked perverted cities. "Strange flesh" being unnatural sexual interaction, homosexuality in Sodom and Gomorrha, and sexual relations with human women in the case of the fallen angels. These "mighty men," the angels' progeny, were Giants on the earth whose thoughts were so wicked that

"every imagination of the thoughts of their heart was only evil continually." Genesis 6:5.

Every culture on earth has strange "myths" of "gods," "demi-gods," "heroes of valour," that reveal beings who were not mere mortals. Many ancient stories tell of these mighty ones being in "love" with women, resulting in the births of the half-human half-divine beings of mythology. Greece has a rich history of supposed interaction between the "gods" and human women. Danae is visited by the god Zeus, she bears a son whom she names Perseus. This same god impregnates a woman called Alcmene, and she brings forth a mighty hero called Hercules. The legendary gods of Olympus all were said to have had sexual relationships with the daughters of men, and had many children to them. Poseidon, god of the sea, was in love with Theophane who was very beautiful. Athene, goddess of wisdom, was said to be the daughter of Zeus and Metis, Metis who was swallowed whole by Zeus out of jealousy that Athene would threaten his reign of power! Apollo was the son of Zeus and the human woman Leto.

READ about these in the library, ancient myths from every culture strongly suggest a real visitation from the angelic realm, as shown in the Bible.

What about INCUBUS and SUCCUBUS?

In these ancient demonology beliefs the devil himself was said to be able to take on the appearance of either a man or a woman and have sexual relations with humans. There was a belief in the Middle Ages that these apparitions could pretend to be either the wife or the husband of the poor mortal attacked. Incubus would

prey on women, and Succubus would attack men. Medieval nuns would sometimes claim to have been raped by Incubi, quite a convenient form of excuse for a "virgin" nun's pregnancy. In ancient Hebrew myth there is a sexually voracious female demon, an Incubus, referred to as the "night hag," her name was Lilith. Incubi were said to gather human sperm as well, to impregnate women. This is intriguing as the present UFO groups contend that ETs are gathering human sperm, male and female, in weird medical labs aboard their "space ships."

Reports of abductions by ETs are at an all time high now, both males and females claim to have been wafted out of their homes into waiting flying saucers to undergo horrifying sexual investigation by ETs.

What is happening in these Endtimes?

**What does Scripture show us about the Nephilim in our day?
AS IT WAS IN THE DAYS OF NOAH.**

"And as it was in the days of Noe [Noah], so shall it be also in the days of the Son of man. They did eat, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, and the flood came, and destroyed them all." Luke 17: 26, 27.

One of the main events that caused God to bring judgment by the Great Flood was the interaction of fallen angels with human women, bringing forth corrupt offspring. In this period of the Latter Days we could well experience this again, we could be already experiencing the take-over of the fallen angels which will culminate in the major stroke of the devil - the Son of Perdition on the throne of the world's kingdoms.
